This agency is working closely with community groups located within the Central District of Baltimore City. We have received the following information concerning your vehicle.

On _____ at or about _____ (____.M.), a vehicle with the tag number of _____ was observed, no less than two times, by a citizen group in the area of _____. The action taken by the driver and/or occupants are consistent with those of a person or persons attempting to engage or engaged in illegal drug or prostitution activity, such as:

1. Repeated driving around or through an area without an obvious reason.
2. Stopping the vehicle and making contact with or talking to **KNOWN DRUG DEALERS** or **PROSTITUTES**.
3. **Drug** transaction or purchase.
4. Prostitutes getting into or out of vehicles.

The Motor Vehicle Administration records show that you are the owner of this vehicle. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the vehicle's whereabouts and the operator's actions. Please advise that person of this letter and that the **citizens** in the area **will continue** to monitor activities in their communities.

Please take note:

This letter will be kept on file at the Central District. If at a future date there is an arrest involving this vehicle (in this area), this letter may be used in court to show ongoing criminal activities. If a conviction is obtained, then your vehicle may be subject to confiscation by the courts.
